The Hawke's Bay A&P Society invites you to enter the 2025 Lawson Robinson Hawke's Bay Scholarship. The Lawson Robinson Hawke's Bay Scholarship aims to recognise outstanding academic and leadership qualities in a student currently enrolled in a full-time land-based production industries programme at a New Zealand University.

The Lawson Robinson Hawke's Bay Scholarship recipient will receive \$3000 *(incl GST)*, payable towards their course fees.

The Scholarship will be presented at the 2025 Napier Port Hawke's Bay Primary Sector Awards dinner, an event which celebrates excellence in the Primary Sector in Hawke's Bay.

Criteria

The recipient must be a full-time student enrolled in a New Zealand tertiary institute in a programme related to land-based production industries at a Graduate or Postgraduate level. Applicants must be in their second to last or final year of study when receiving this scholarship.

The recipient will have a familial association with Hawke's Bay and is or has been involved in the practical aspects of the industry to which the programme is linked.

The criteria for selection will be based on leadership potential and academic merit. It is hoped that scholarship recipients will ultimately seek employment in Hawke's Bay and pass on the benefits of their learning to the Hawke's Bay community and its industries.

The Scholarship will be awarded by a Selection Committee of three members comprising:

- A representative from Lawson Robinson.
- A representative from the Hawke's Bay A&P Society.
- A recognised leader from the farming community selected and agreed by Lawson Robinson and the Hawke's Bay A&P Society.
