Hawke's Bay A&P Show General Conditions

The following General Conditions are to be read in conjunction with Section Conditions and with the Rules and Bylaws of the Royal Agricultural Society (RAS) of New Zealand.

1. PRIVACY ACT

- The A&P Society holds records of names and addresses of all Members, Trade Exhibitors and Competitors and may publish these for the purposes of Show media reports or promotional purposes at the A&P Society's discretion.
- The A&P Society may take photographs and video images of Members, Trade Exhibitors, Competitors, exhibits (including livestock) and the employees, agents and assistants of any Trade Exhibitor or Competitor and use this information for reporting or promotional purposes in any media, at the A&P Society's discretion.

2. HEALTH & SAFETY

Competitors must

- Comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 and any amendments thereafter.
- Supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created
 or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the
 Showgrounds. The Society reserves the right to order immediate removal from the
 Showgrounds any animal it considers unruly, dangerous or unmanageable.
- · Follow the instructions of Marshals and Officials.
- Ensure that they keep walkways clear, and no dangerous equipment or chemicals are accessible to the public.
- Report accidents to the Horse Office or Show Office.
- In any livestock parade, children aged under 12 years leading cattle are to be accompanied by an adult. Any animal 2 years or over must be led by a person aged 16 years and over.
- NO SMOKING the Tomoana Showgrounds are a Smokefree area. Any person found smoking will be fined \$500.
- All persons admitted into any premises controlled by the Hawke's Bay A&P Society shall
 be subject to the orders of the Committee and, in the event of misbehaviour on the part of
 anyone attending the Show, such person may be removed by order of the Society. This
 applies to any person whose conduct, either personally or as proprietor of a side-show, or
 exhibit, is a source of annoyance.
- The Hawke's Bay A&P Society will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage that may be caused directly or indirectly to or suffered by an exhibit.
- Persons occupying grandstands, buildings and other structures or other seating accommodation on the Showgrounds do so at their own risk.
- The full Health & Safety Policy & Management Plan is available at the Show Office.

3. First Aid

• First aid stations are located by the Horse Office and on the other side of the Oval. Please familiarise yourself with the Showgrounds site map.

4. RIGHTS OF THE HAWKE'S BAY A&P SOCIETY

The Hawke's Bay A&P Society reserves the right to, at any time, for any reason and without notice to:

- · Refuse or cancel any entry
- Alter the Show timetable
- Withdraw or change any event or class
- Amalgamate classes where there are insufficient entries
- Remove any dangerous or inappropriate exhibit or display

The decision of the Society is final. Competitors will be notified if classes are to be amalgamated.

5. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Entries for all Livestock are to be submitted online at www.evoevents.co.nz. If you need help with this process, please contact the Event Secretary, who will help you.
- Entries received after 9th October may not be catalogued.
- All entries close midnight 9th October.
- Late entries may not be permitted for Livestock.
- It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure their details of entries are correct.
- Entry into the Show entitles the Hawke's Bay A&P Society to publish a competitors' name, photos and videos.

7. SCRATCHINGS

- Application for refunds must include a vet certificate or medical certificate.
- 100% refund will be paid until close of entry, 27th September
- 50% refund will be paid from 28th September.
- Competitors MUST notify the Secretary, secretary@hbap.co.nz

8. ENTRY PASSES

- There will be no passes posted out to competitors in 2025. Competitors will receive a
 vehicle entry ticket via Flickit. Passes will be collected at the event, with the process to be
 emailed to competitors prior to event.
- Each competitor will receive 1 wristband on entry.
- If more tickets are required, please purchase these when completing the entry process.

9. PARKING

- All vehicles/drivers must display the gate entry ticket to gain entry to the Show. Please ensure you access the allocated gate.
- For vehicles to remain in this area after hours, a 'camping' ticket must be displayed which will also be in your Show Pack.

10. ACCOMMODATION

- All competitors that require accommodation on site must book and pay for camping at time of entry.
- Competitors will be allocated a camping ticket that must be displayed to have 24-hour access to this area.
- Vehicles that do not display this camping ticket will be issued a fine of \$20 each day.
- All Livestock competitors must camp in behind the cattle and pig stalls.
- There is to be NO camping of any kind in public accessed areas or within competition areas.
- Showers and toilets are provided in the permanent toilet block.

11. RAS RULES

- The RAS Judges & Competitors Rulebook (see www.ras.org.nz) sets out all the conditions that apply to the classes and sections offered. Each Breed that is affiliated to the RAS offer their own standard schedule of classes and any additional rules that apply to showing their particular breed.
- Should any person or firm be disqualified or suspended by another Association or affiliated organisation of the Royal Agricultural Society, the suspension or disqualification may also be applied by the affiliate organisations.

12. CATALOGUES

- Catalogue information will be available online at evoevents.co.nz or \$10 each at the Show Office.
- If you pre-ordered a Catalogue through the entry process, collect these from your section's Chief Steward.
- The timings in this schedule may change once final entries are received and the catalogue is produced.

13. STARTING TIMES

- Starting times are approximate only but the Show will endeavour to adhere to as closely as possible. When a competitor may have two classes, they have entered running simultaneously then they must elect which class they compete in. Our judges and stewards will do their best to work with everyone to the best of their ability.
- To be read in conjunction with the relevant section conditions and rules and By-Laws of the Royal Agriculture Society of New Zealand.

14. LATE ENTRIES & CHANGES DURING THE SHOW

• Late entries are not permitted from 16 October 2024 and therefore entries during the Show are not permitted.

15. PROTESTS

All protests must be in writing and may be lodged with the Section Chief Steward/Section
Head one hour from the completion of the class judged, together with a deposit of \$50
which shall be returned should the protest to upheld. No protest will be received later than
one hour after the ribbons are affixed.

16. TROPHIES & CUPS

- All recipients of Hawke's Bay A&P Society trophies, cups and other perpetual prizes are
 required to take prize upon winning however, to remove the prize from the Showgrounds,
 the recipient must sign for the prize and provide contact details.
- All trophies must be returned clean, engraved and in good condition to the Section Head or the Show Office by 1st August the following year. The prize will then be signed back into the care of the Hawke's Bay A&P Society.
- Permission of removal of a trophy is at the discretion of the Hawke's Bay A&P Society and the Section Convenor. Only a selection of trophies are allowed to be removed from the Showgrounds.

17. PREPARATION FOR DEPARTURE

- Clean out all animal housing to the standard of your Section Head.
- Notify your Section Head of any damage or repairs and maintenance required.
- Remove all rubbish and personal belongings.
- Check with the Section Head prior to departure to see that your animal housing is satisfactory.
- Check your individual schedules for any specific details related to the section.
- Pay all outstanding fees before departing the Showgrounds.

18. PRIZE MONEY

- Any prize money will be paid into a nominated bank account within 30 days (subject to any
 queries). You will be sent an email via Evo Events asking you to verify your bank account
 number. This needs to be done before prize money can be paid out.
- Any disputes regarding prize money must be made no later than 30 November, as no payments will be made after this date.
- The payout scale is as follows:
- a. In classes with three (3) or less entries, only 1st place will be awarded and paid.
- b. In classes with four (4) or more entries, 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be awarded and paid.

19. REFUND POLICY - Cancellation of the Show

- To provide confidence in competing at this year's Hawke's Bay A&P Show, all competitors will receive a 100% refund on entry fees if the Hawke's Bay A&P Show were to be cancelled prior to the 9 October 2024.
- In the unlikely event the Hawke's Bay A&P Show were to be cancelled from the 10 October 2024, competitors will receive a refund of their entry fees minus the administration and grounds fee.

20. Non competing animals

 All non-competing animals, including dogs are banned from the Hawke's Bay Showgrounds.

21. MOTORBIKES

• Competitors are NOT permitted to use motorbikes unless an exemption is granted by the General Manager in advance of the Show.

22.BEHAVIOUR & CONDUCT - In-Line Resolution Process

- This Show supports the RAS In-Line Resolution Process Policy, which will operate in all sections and will be used for any inappropriate behaviour towards Show officials, judges, fellow competitors or any other third party connected with the Show.
- The full working of the policy is available to view on the RAS website.

Birds to be penned at the Poultry Shed (next to the Exhibition Hall) no earlier than 5pm and no later than 7.30pm on Wednesday 22nd October. Enter via Gate 3 off Kenilworth Road. Poultry Shed, 8.30am – 1pm, Thursday 23rd October.

Poultry

All birds must be healthy and free of parasites.

Arrival & Penning: Birds to be penned at the Poultry Shed (next to the Exhibition Hall) no earlier than 5pm and no later than 7.30pm on Wednesday 22nd October. Enter via Gate 3 off Kenilworth Road.?

Wool

- Please read these Section Conditions alongside the General Conditions of the Hawke's Bay A&P Show.
- All Champion & Reserve Fleeces must be available for entry into the National Golden Fleece Awards.
- All fleeces are to be shown SKIRTED without bellies, neck fold or heavy conditioned points. This allows the selection of the fleece at the wool table during normal shearing procedure.
- Each fleece must have the name of the Competitor and class number attached.
- Fleeces presented must be the property of a bona fide farmer, but it is not necessary that the competitor is the breeder of the sheep.
- All fleeces must have been shorn within the preceding 12 months and must not be more than one season's growth of wool. Wool with tupping crayon on it should not be skirted out. Fleeces will not be discounted for this.
- The Sheep Committee reserves the right to change the classes or conditions.
- The judges may, at their own discretion, change fleeces from the classes that they have entered, into their correct classes without prejudice to the competitors.
- Points for weight to be on a clean scoured basis and allocated by reference to the specially drawn up table which converts the greasy weight to a clean basis.

Judging: Fleeces will be judged on Tuesday 21st October and displayed in the Fleece Marquee for the duration of the Show.
