The recipient must be an individual who demonstrates commitment, passion and leadership in their chosen career within the primary industries. Nominations should demonstrate leadership the individual has shown and their impact on the industry.

Those nominated should also demonstrate their commitment to the primary industries and how they have made and can make, develop and progress the sector.

Criteria

The Craigs Investment Partners Hawke's Bay Emerging Leader will have:

- Shown outstanding future potential leadership in less than ten years.
- Show proven evidence of their commitment and passion for the organisation and the wider sector.
- Demonstrate the ability to work with and help build successful teams.
- Displayed some or all the following characteristics: determination and will to succeed, belief in achieving extraordinary things, a willingness to learn, a desire for constant improvement, initiative to pursue an idea, trusting and empowering teammates, working hard, high standards of integrity.
