ENTRY FORM

Criteria

The competition is open to any horticulture grower as defined by Horticulture NZ, including landowners, lessees and managers based in the Hawke's Bay region and defined by the Hawke's Bay Regional Council boundary.

The horticulture business must be a full-time operation for at least one person.

Entrants must be pursuing a system of horticulture which will maintain a high sustainable performance over a long term.

Judging Is based on the following criteria.

- **Innovation:** New ideas, above and beyond the norm, creativity, leader-not fast follower in adopting new technology, leader development, marketing / optimising value.
- **Resilience:** Climate, marketing, diversity, risk management, forward planning, succession planning, crop management, governance.
- **Leadership:** Industry good, community management, at own business scale, professional development.
- **Education:** Training- young/old, self-development, mentoring, stewardship.
- **Social:** Health and wellbeing, community engagement, at own business scale, professional development.

Entrants must supply written and photographic evidence on a USB stick to support the criteria. Photographic evidence must include an image of yourself/yourselves. These images will also be used for promotional purposes if required, please only submit images that can be used.

With the winner's co-operation an open field day, organised and managed by Hawke's Bay A&P Society will be held on the winner's property.

All award runner ups will be kept anonymous.

Recognition of being the Hawke's Bay Horticulturalist of the Year. \$1500 cash.
