

Show Jumping

Please read these in conjunction with the Hawkes Bay A&P Show's Equestrian Conditions.

- A horse/pony may only have two starts per day, with the exception of the Rising Stars who may start in 2014, 2015 and 2016.
- If classes have excess entries the classes will be divided, and prize money adjusted.
- In the case of larger entries, prize money may be increased, as per Article 248.7 "It is compulsory that all advertised prize money in the schedule be paid out to all eligible competitors as a minimum and for larger classes there be a minimum ratio of 1 prize for every 7 starters".
- The best efforts have been made to provide suitable warm up and competition arenas. By entering you understand these efforts have been made and accept the conditions provided.
- Times stated in the Schedule for Jumping Competitions are approximate only and will be adjusted after entries close according to entries received. The Hawke's Bay Show reserves the right to start an event before the catalogued time.

In Arena 1, Competitors are expected to jump in the order as drawn and printed in the EvoEvents. All riders are to suitably attired when entering the ring, and competitors will be expected to wear jackets.

- ARENA 1 -Draw order as per EvoEvents.
- ARENA 2 -Blackboard order
- Overlap -Consideration shall be shown to competitors who are entered in competition that may overlap. Please see the Judge concerned but classes will not be delayed.

- All riders must be ESNZ registered.
- For all classes, (except introductory classes. Horses 90cm and under Ponies 80cm and under.) riders must have a full ESNZ membership, horses must be registered with ESNZ and have a current ESNZ Jumping annual start or may use a casual start if 1.10m and under (horses), or 1.00m and under (ponies). Refer to levy table.
- ESNZ fees will be charged as per ESNZ guidelines on Evo Events.
- Horses and Ponies cannot compete in Series Classes with a Casual Start.
