FutureUp with Futureopoly – \$TBC per Student, Adults Free

We have partnered with the Graeme Dingle Foundation to offer your students the great opportunity to learn more and get excited about potential vocational career pathways in food, fibre or primary industries. This is in an effort to ensure students are aware of opportunities available to them in the future, enable them to make informed choices about their career and increase their confidence talking to adults. Based on the well-known game Monopoly, groups will move between education modules set up with local businesses in different sectors. Groups will spend 12 minutes completing an activity and interview at each module in order to collect points.



Handmade Competition – \$TBC Entry Fee

Students have the opportunity to enter their handmade creations into the Handmade Competition and be in to win one of the many cash or gift voucher prizes across the classes. There is no age limit to entering this competition, each item entered incurs a \$TBC entry fee (+GST). Entries close 5pm Saturday 27th September and judging will take place the following week. All entries will be displayed in the Exhibition Hall throughout the Show and Prizegiving will take place at 9:30am Friday 24th October in the Showcase Hall. Each entrant will receive 1x free competitor pass to attend the competition and prizegiving.



Design, Make & Model Showcase – \$TBC Entry Fee

Hop up on stage and strut your stuff! The Design, Make & Model Showcase encourages students to enter wearable creations which they have skillfully designed and assembled over the year. The overall winning school will receive a voucher to the value of a Bernette sewing machine. Prizes in the form of a sash, certificate and gift voucher will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd placings in each class, there will also be overall trophies awarded for the best upcycled garment, and the best garment made with natural fibres, so be sure to register your interest in these if applicable when submitting your entry online. The Showcase will take place at 10am Thursday 23rd at the Show.



Schools Art Competition – Free to Enter

School classes are invited to submit their Creative and Digital artworks into the Schools Art Competition. Due to the number of school entries a maximum of 10 entries from each school class will be accepted (Schools may need to do some pre-judging). Anything from sculptures, paintings, collages, photographs, drawings, graphic designs and more are welcomed! Artworks will be displayed throughout the Show within the Showcase Hall (until 2pm Friday) in the relevant entrant age group with Prize Cards displayed.



Community Performance Stage – Free to Enter

The Community Performance Stage is a fun, non-competitive opportunity for individuals, duos and groups of any age to show off their talents to the wider Hawke's Bay Community. This could be anything from music bands/solos, dance groups, cultural groups, choir groups, poetry/story telling, acting out a skit or anything in-between. 10-20 minute time slots will be available on both days of the Show. Speakers and a microphone will be available for your use, however performers are required to provide and manage any other special equipment needed.



Hobby Horse Race – Free to Enter

We will be holding a Hobby Horse Race at 2pm Friday 24th October in the Showing Blue Ring. Open to the public and with no age limit, we encourage both students and teachers to buy, borrow or make their own Hobby Horse to bring along to the Show and participate in this fun-for-all competition.
