Hawke's Bay A&P Show General Conditions

The following General Conditions are to be read in conjunction with Section Conditions and with the Rules and Bylaws of the Royal Agricultural Society (RAS) of New Zealand.

1. PRIVACY ACT

The A&P Society holds records of names and addresses of all Members, Trade Exhibitors and Competitors and may publish these for the purposes of Show media reports or promotional purposes at the A&P Society's discretion.

The A&P Society may take photographs and video images of Members, Trade Exhibitors, Competitors, exhibits (including livestock) and the employees, agents and assistants of any Trade Exhibitor or Competitor and use this information for reporting or promotional purposes in any media, at the A&P Society's discretion.

2. HEALTH & SAFETY

Competitors must

- Comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 and any amendments thereafter.
- Supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the Showgrounds. The Society reserves the right to order immediate removal from the Showgrounds any animal it considers unruly, dangerous or unmanageable.
- Follow the instructions of Marshals and Officials.
- Ensure that they keep walkways clear, and no dangerous equipment or chemicals are accessible to the public.
- Report accidents to the Horse Office or Show Office.

In any livestock parade, children aged under 12 years leading cattle are to be accompanied by an adult. Any animal 2 years or over must be led by a person aged 16 years and over.

NO SMOKING in the horse stables or yards, animal housing, arenas or pavilions. Any person found smoking within these areas will be fined \$500.

All persons admitted into any premises controlled by the Hawke's Bay A&P Society shall be subject to the orders of the Committee and, in the event of misbehaviour on the part of anyone attending the Show such person may be removed by order of the Society. This applies to any person whose conduct, either personal or as proprietor of a side-show, or exhibit, is a source of annoyance. The Hawke's Bay A&P Society will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage that may be caused directly or indirectly to or suffered by an exhibit.

Persons occupying grandstands, buildings and other structures or other seating accommodation on the Showgrounds do so at their own risk.

The full Health & Safety Policy & Management Plan is available at the Show Office and is available on the Show website and with the Chief Steward/Head of Section.

2.1. First Aid

First aid stations are located by the Horse Office and under the Grandstand. Please familiarise yourself with the Showgrounds site map.

3. RIGHTS OF THE HAWKE'S BAY A&P SOCIETY

The Hawke's Bay A&P Society reserves the right to, at any time, for any reason and without notice to:

- Refuse or cancel any entry
- Alter the Show timetable
- Withdraw or change any event or class
- Amalgamate classes where there are insufficient entries
- Remove any dangerous or inappropriate exhibit or display

The decision of the Society is final. Competitors will be notified is classes are to be amalgamated.

4. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Entries for all Livestock are to be submitted online at <u>www.evoevents.co.nz</u>. If you need help with this process, please contact the Entries Coordinator, who will help you.
- Entries received after 27th September may not be catalogued.
- All entries close midnight 27th September except for:
 - a. Dog Trials, close 29th September.
- Late entries are not permitted for Livestock.
- There is no receipt of entry unless requested.
- It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure their details of entries are correct.
- Entry in the Show entitles the Hawke's Bay A&P Society to publish a competitors' name in results and distribute with Competitor Lists.
- The Society reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without adducing any reason for doing so.

6. SCRATCHINGS

- Application for refunds must include a vet certificate or medical certificate.
- 100% refund will be paid until close of entry, 27th September
- 50% refund will be paid from 28th September.
- Competitors MUST notify the Entries Coordinators, entries@hawkesbayshow.co.nz.

7. ENTRY PASSES

- Competitors will receive a Show Pack via post, this pack will include specific details including entry wristbands, maps, entry gate, parking and camping areas/passes.
- Entry tickets for Helpers (grooms, leaders, handlers etc) will be allocated as follows:
- Competitors with 1 animal will receive 1 entry ticket.
- Competitors with 2 animals will receive 2 entry tickets.
- Competitors with 3 plus animals will receive 3 entry tickets.
- If more tickets are required, please purchase these when completing the entry process.

8. PARKING

- All vehicles/drivers must display the gate entry ticket to gain entry to the Show. Please ensure you access the allocated gate.
- For vehicles to remain in this area after hours, a 'camping' ticket must be displayed which will also be in your Show Pack.

9. ACCOMMODATION

- All competitors that require accommodation on site must book and pay for camping at time of entry.
- Competitors will be allocated a camping ticket that must be displayed to have 24-hour access to this area.
- Vehicles that do not display this camping ticket will be issued a fine of \$20 each day.
- All Livestock competitors must camp in the gate 15 area of Showgrounds in behind the cattle and pig stalls.
- There is to be NO camping of any kind in public accessed areas or within competition areas.
- Showers and toilets are provided.

10. HOUSING FOR LIVESTOCK ANIMALS

- Housing is charged at no cost but needs to be booked through the entry process.

11. RAS RULES

- The RAS Judges & Competitors Rulebook (see www.ras.org.nz) sets out all the conditions that apply to the classes and sections offered. Each Breed that is affiliated to the RAS offer their own standard schedule of classes and any additional rules that apply to showing their particular breed.
- Should any person or firm be disqualified or suspended by another Association or affiliated organisation of the Royal Agricultural Society, the suspension or disqualification may also be applied by the affiliate organisations.

12. CATALOGUES

- Catalogue information will be available online at evoevents.co.nz or \$10 each at the Show Office.
- If you pre-ordered a Catalogue through the entry process, collect these from your section's Chief Steward.
- The timings in this schedule may change once final entries are received and the catalogue is produced.

13. STARTING TIMES

- Starting times are approximate only but the Show will endeavour to adhere to as closely as possible. When a competitor may have two classes they have entered running simultaneously then they must elect which class they compete in. Our judges and stewards will do their best to work in with everyone to the best of their ability.
- To be read in conjunction with the relevant section conditions and rules and By-Laws of the Royal Agriculture Society of New Zealand.

14. LATE ENTRIES & CHANGES DURING THE SHOW

- Late entries are not permitted from 10 October 2022 and therefore entries during the Show are not permitted.

15. PROTESTS

- All protests must be in writing and may be lodged with the Section Chief Steward/Section Head one hour from the completion of the class judged, together with a deposit of \$50 which shall be returned should the protest to upheld. No protest will be received later than one hour after the ribbons are affixed.

16. TROPHIES & CUPS

- All recipients of Hawke's Bay A&P Society trophies, cups and other perpetual prizes are required to take prize upon winning however to remove the prize from the Showgrounds, the recipient must sign for the prize and provide contact details.
- All trophies must be returned clean, engraved and in good condition to the Section Head or the Show Office by 1 August the following year. The prize will then be signed back into the care of the Hawke's Bay A&P Society.
- Permission of removal of a trophy is at the discretion of the Hawke's Bay A&P Society and the Section Convenor. Only a selection of trophies are allowed to be removed from the Showgrounds.

17. PREPARATION FOR DEPARTURE

- Clean out all animal housing to the standard of your Section Head.
- Notify your Section Head of any damage or repairs and maintenance required.
- Remove all rubbish and personal belongings.
- Check with the Section Head prior to departure that your animal housing is satisfactory.
- Check your individual schedules for any specific details related to the section.
- Pay all outstanding fees before departing the Showgrounds.

18. PRIZE MONEY

- Any prize money will be paid into a nominated bank account within 30 days (subject to any queries). You will be sent an email via EvoEvents asking you to verify your bank account number. This needs to be done before prize money can be paid out.
- Any disputes regarding prize money must be made no later than 30 November.
- The payout scale is as follows:
 - a. In classes with four (4) or less entries, only 1st place will be awarded and paid.
 - b. In classes with five (5) or more entries, 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be awarded and paid.

19. REFUND POLICY - Cancellation of the Show

To provide confidence in competing at this year's Hawke's Bay A&P Show, all competitors will receive a 100% refund on entry fees if the Hawke's Bay A&P Show were to be cancelled prior to the 9 October 2023.

In the unlikely event the Hawke's Bay A&P Show were to be cancelled from the 10 October 2023, competitors will receive a refund of their entry fees minus the administration and grounds fee.

20. DOGS

All non-competing dogs are banned from the Hawke's Bay Showgrounds.

21. MOTORBIKES

Competitors are NOT permitted to use motorbikes unless exemption is granted from General Manager in advance of the Show.

22. BEHAVIOUR & CONDUCT - In-Line Resolution Process

- This Show supports the RAS In-Line Resolution Process Policy, which will operate in all sections and will be used for any inappropriate behaviour towards Show officials, judges, fellow competitors or any other third party connected with the Show.

- Hawke's Bay Competitors are not eligible for day preference.

- Dogs will run according to the draw.
- All dogs must have current council registration, in excellent health and are dosed for Sheep Measles no later than 48hrs before entering the Showgrounds.
- All classes and types of dogs entering trial grounds must have Ovis Certificates of no more than 30 days prior to trial.
- Online entries at <u>www.hbap.co.nz</u> are preferred. Please contact the entries team if you are unable to enter online.

Arrival: Dog Trail competitor entry will be Gate 3 off Kenilworth Road. Please see information in your entry pack for more information.

Judging: Dog Trial Arena, start times to be confirmed for each day. Heats will be run Wednesday 18 & Thursday 19 October with Finals being run on Friday 20 October.

Conditions of Entry

- Please read these Section Conditions alongside the General Conditions of the Hawke's Bay A&P Show.
- All Pigs over 12 months must be registered with a Pig Breed Society affiliated to the Royal Agricultural Society of NZ. Herd Book numbers must be stated on the entry form.
- All pigs under 12 months must be eligible for registration with a Pig Breed Society affiliated to the Royal Agricultural Society of NZ.
- All boars over 12 months must be detusked no less than 3 weeks prior to Show.
- Any class with less than 3 entries may be combined as appropriate.
- Where there are less than three entries in a class, only 1st place prize money will be awarded.

Pork Lords

- All pigs in Pork Lords competition must be less than 12 months old.
- Pigs that have competed in the registered pig section (Thursday) are not eligible to compete in the Pork Lords competition.
- All Syndicates must enter a pie in the bacon and egg pie competition.

The Pork Lords classes will be

- 1. Best commercial sow
- 2. Best commercial boar
- 3. Best Baconer
- 4. Best Porker

The 4 winners of each of the classes go into Championship class to decide who wins the overall Pork Lords shield.

Each pig will be in two classes, either boar or sow and either Baconer or Porker.

- All pigs in Pork Lords competition must be less than 12 months old.
- •Pigs that have competed in the registered pig section (Thursday) are not eligible to compete in the Pork Lords competition.
- •All Syndicates must enter a pie in the bacon and egg pie competition.

Arrival & Penning: Enter via Gate 13 off Elwood Road. Pigs will be housed in the pig pens next to The Farm Yard.

All competitors or handlers must place their animals in the pens allocated. All pigs must be penned by 9.00am on Friday 20 October.

Judging: Pig Arena, 9.00am, Friday 20 October.

- All birds must be healthy and free of parasites.

Arrival & Penning: Birds to be penned at the Poultry Shed (next to the Exhibition Hall) no earlier than 5pm and no later than 7.30pm on Wednesday 18 October. Enter via Gate 3 off Kenilworth Road.

For parking during Show days, please use Gate 1.

Conditions of Entry

- Please read these Section Conditions alongside the General Conditions of the Hawke's Bay A&P Show.
- Sheep must be shown in the class entered no changes can be made.
- In all ewe & lamb classes the quality of lambs is to be taken into consideration in all judging. Competitors are asked to note that in Ewe and Lamb Classes, lambs must be her suckling lambs.
- Imported sheep lambed in April shall be deemed to have been born on the last day of the month.
- Definition of Hogget: A sheep born after 1 July in any one year shall be considered a hogget up to and including 31 December the following year except in the case of the Dorset Horn and Poll Dorset sheep when 1 May should be substituted for 1 July.
- Hoggets are eligible for Championship Judging.
- If any injection or dosing is given to any animal the competitor must report this action to the Chief Steward of the section or to the Supervisor before undertaking it.

Shearing Dates

- Sheep must be un-shorn unless otherwise stated. Date of previous shearing must be given when entry is made. Age to be declared in every case at time of entry. The age of sheep must date from the end of the third week after lambing commences.
- All Sheep in pedigree Shorn classes must be shorn no earlier than 20 July in the current year, and no later than 28 days prior to the date of the Show. Except in the case of mutton bred sheep where the shearing date shall be on or after the 1 September of that current year.
- In the case of Black and Coloured Sheep, the shearing date is on or after 20 May of that current year.

Brucellosis Testing

- All competitors must sign a declaration stating that rams entered for the Show are either:
 - from a flock currently accredited brucellosis free
 - o OR have no palpable lesion of epididymitis and have received a negative test for ovine brucellosis.
- Copies of the accreditation certificate or the test certificate must be forwarded with the entry form.

Arrival & Penning: Sheep will be housed in the Sheep Pavilion pens. Enter via Gate 13 off Elwood Road. Please ensure your vehicle is parked in the 'camping' area, NOT left in front of the Wool Shed.

All competitors or handlers must place their animals in the pens allocated by the Convenor. A limited amount of straw will be provided for bedding in the Sheep Section.

- All night pens are to be advised to the Showgrounds by 30 September by ticking the appropriate box during entry. Sheep must be unloaded in pens no later than 7pm on Wednesday 18 October unless pre organised with Nick Sullivan.
- Access to the Sheep Pavilion will be available on Thursday 19 October from 7am. Any competitors wanting to arrive prior to this time, will need permission from the Chief Steward.
- All animals must be penned for judging by 10am Thursday 19 October.
- For Friday's All Breeds classes, pen numbers must be brought to the Sheep Breeders office no later than 3pm on Thursday.
- The Society reserves the right to divide existing pens for the purpose of penning animals, should the entries necessitate such action.

Breed Judging: Sheep Pavilion, 10am, Thursday 19 October & 9am, Friday 20 October.

- All breeders within the district and their affiliates are welcome to apply for acceptance into this Society.
- Invitation is also extended to all competitors from the current and previous year's sheep competitions including those visiting from out of the district.
- Access to the restricted hospitality area is permitted for those displaying their HBEBS ribbon. Exclusive access to morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea.
- The Hawke's Bay Sheep Breeders committee have the right to accept or deny any application.
- Please indicate on your entry form to be considered.

Conditions of Entry

- Please read these Section Conditions alongside the General Conditions of the Hawke's Bay A&P Show.
- All Champion & Reserve Fleeces must be available for entry into the National Golden Fleece Awards.
- All fleeces are to be shown SKIRTED without bellies, neck fold or heavy conditioned points. This allows the selection of the fleece at the wool table during normal shearing procedure.
- Each fleece must have the name of the Competitor and class number attached.
- Fleeces presented must be the property of a bona fide farmer, but it is not necessary that the competitor is the breeder of the sheep.
- All fleeces must have been shorn within the preceding 12 months and must not be more than one season's growth of wool. Wool with tupping crayon on it should not be skirted out. Fleeces will not be discounted for this.
- The Sheep Committee reserves the right to change the classes or conditions.
- The judges may, at their own discretion, change fleeces from the classes that they have entered, into their correct classes without prejudice to the competitors.
- Points for weight to be on a clean scoured basis and allocated by reference to the specially drawn up table which converts the greasy weight to a clean basis.

Judging: Fleeces will be judged on Tuesday 17 October and displayed in the Fleece Marquee for the duration of the Show.
